Fees, Funded Hours and Quality Premium

Each Peach's philosophy ensures that our setting will provide the highest standards of physical and emotional care for children in a happy and secure atmosphere. Our highly trained team of Nursery Teachers, many of which are qualified to Teacher Status level, are committed to the long-term outcomes for children ensuring that they receive the highest quality curriculum and teaching right up until they leave for school. We go above and beyond in our setting and provide fresh, home cooked meals and snacks prepared on site by our Nursery Chef, extra-curricular activities, external visitors, forest school and trips out at for an optional cost which is charged at £44 per week or if accessing less than the funded hours £2 per hour

Please see below for further information, all additional that are not covered in the low rate given by the Government.

Quality Premium Fee = £44 per week 22 hours / £22 per week for 11 hours

What do my funded government hours cover?

The funded hours offered to you by the government are intended to cover the delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage, all our extra services go beyond the EYFS as does our Outstanding provision.

Why does Each Peach Forest School charge extra fees?

The funding does not accurately represent the true cost of high quality childcare. In order for us to maintain our beautiful nursery, continue to pay our staff well and offer the extra services we do, we need to be able to pay for things like gardeners, tree surgeons, skip hire, forest school equipment, staff training along with the standard costs such as business rates, utilities and rent. Unfortunately the amount of funding we receive from the government is not enough for us to be able to maintain the high Each Peach standard, offer extras such as trips and external visitors along with maintaining the site, which is why we ask for the optional extra charges.

Do I have to pay the above charges?

No, you can opt for these charges, funded only hours are available every day between 1pm-6pm and are subject to availability.

Do I have to book additional hours on top of the funded hours?

No you can just use your funded hours and not add on full paying hours however this may mean we are unable to accommodate all your funded hours as our afternoon sessions are 5 hours long. For example you could use 20 hours over 4 afternoon sessions, we are unable to accommodate less than 5 hours in one session.

What do I need to provide myself if I decided not to pay the above charges and attend funded only afternoon sessions if available?

Meals & Snacks: you will need to provide healthy and nutritious meals & snacks for your child to eat at nursery, you will be provided with the guidelines set by us of what you are able to provide for your child based on healthy eating guidelines. We ask you to provide your Childs high tea as close to the menu as possible and following healthy eating guidelines and allergens.

Consumables: If your child is in nappies you will be required to send in 10 nappies each afternoon for our teachers to use along with a barrier cream - unfortunately due to lack of storage this is not something we can keep for you at nursery so you will need to pack this in your Childs bag each day. If your child requires formula you will need to provide unopened formula that can live at nursery for up to 2 weeks.

All children must be provided with a pack of wipes and suncream (must be Nivea)

If your child has naps during the day you will need to provide bedding

What will my child do if attending funded only afternoon sessions?

Your child will have access to our front playground and internal areas however they will be unable to access the back field and facilities as these are used for the forest school activities.
