We go above and beyond in our setting and provide fresh, home cooked meals and snacks prepared on site by our Nursery Chef, extra-curricular activities, external visitors, forest school and trips out at for an optional cost which is charged at £33 per week or if accessing less than the funded hours £1.50 per hour

3 days attendance using 22 hours of funding (8.30am-5.30pm)

22 hours = £0.00 + Quality premium = £33

5 hours non-funded = £45.25

Total weekly fee = £78.25

3 days attendance using 11 hours of funding (8.30am-5.30pm)

11 hours = £0.00 + Quality premium = £16.50

16 hours non-funded = £144.80

5 half days attendance using 22 hours of funding (8.30am-1pm)

22 hours = £0.00 + Quality premium = £33

F&Q's

What do my funded government hours cover?

The funded hours offered to you by the government are intended to cover the delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage, all our extra services go beyond the EYFS as does our provision.

Why does Each Peach Childcare charge extra fees?

The funding does not accurately represent the true cost of high quality childcare. In order for us to maintain our beautiful nursery, continue to pay our staff well and offer the extra services we do we ask for the optional extra charges.

Do I have to pay the above charges?

No, you can opt out of the extra charges, in this instance funded only hours can be accessed every afternoon between 1pm-5.30pm and this is subject to availability.

What do I need to provide myself if I decided not to pay the above charges and attend during the afternoon sessions if available?

Meals & Snacks: you will need to provide healthy and nutritious meals & snacks for your child to eat at nursery, you will be provided with the guidelines set by us of what you are able to provide for your child based on healthy eating guidelines. We ask that you provide your Childs high tea as close to our nursery menu as possible following the healthy eating guidelines and allergens.

Consumables: If your child is in nappies you will be required to send in 10 nappies each day for our teachers to use along with a barrier cream - unfortunately due to lack of storage this is not something we can keep for you at nursery so you will need to pack this in your Childs bag each day. If your child requires formula you will need to provide unopened formula that can live at nursery for up to 2 weeks.

All children must be provided with a pack of wipes and suncream (must be Nivea)
